
A harmonious alliance between East and West

Behind the classical facade of a period building, the contemporary decor staged by Marc Hertrich & Nicolas Adnet, is a surprising yet subtle blend of eastern and western contrasts, mixing tradition and technology, elegance and wit, in a subtle play of light and shade.

Visitors discover the hotel through a circular window reminiscent of a traditional moon gate in a Chinese garden. The entrance area sets a tone of surprising contrasts. Two Asian thrones in unvarnished wood, coincidentally evoking the furniture of a mountain chalet, are countered by a shocking pink sofa, inviting guests to sink back in comfort.

A central fireplace underlines the hotel's warm welcome and outside, the patio takes on the appearance of a life-size painting. In front of a waterwall framed by ivy and bamboo plants, an imposing vase from the Ateliers Prométhée invites contemplation. Its black lacquer echoes the red of the two Chinese ceramic vases marking the passage between interior and exterior.

The two cultures, East and West, keep their traditional and contemporary elements in balance.



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The art of living away from home

With its intimate atmosphere and easygoing elegance, this exclusive address has the feel of home away from home. Discreet luxury, cosy comfort and attentive service define the art of living at EASTWEST HOTEL. Everything has been designed with the greatest attention to detail, ensuring relaxation and enjoyment.

Inside guest rooms, parquet floors and minimally designed dark wood furniture complement the shifting reflections of shimmering fabrics to create a contemporary, elegant and warm atmosphere. In some rooms, adjustable sliding wood panels – a nod to the Orient – allow guests to rearrange the space according to their needs. The quality of materials and finishings can be found in the smallest details, such as the leather wardrobe handles and finely embroidered throws.

The **41 rooms, including 2 junior suites and 2 duplex suites**, are equipped with all comforts modern technology can bring: individually controlled air conditioning, minibar, private safe, pleasant and functional working space, Wifi and high-speed Internet access. They offer furnishing and features that motivate guests to return, such as beds of exceptional quality, dimmer-switch light controls, 32-inch-screen interactive cable television, and a Nespresso coffee machine in every room.

The bathrooms feature the same attention to detail: Frette bathrobes and bath towels, slippers, hair dryers,, illuminated make-up mirrors and cosmetic products from Anne Semonin, a pioneer in the use of micronutrients with essential oils.

The 2 duplex suites, featuring floor-to-ceiling glass, open onto the patio to take advantage of this oasis in the heart of town. On the ground floor, a crocodile-patterned wall gives structure to the living room. The staircase leads to the bedroom and a spacious bathroom. The decor is intended to remind each guest of the comfort of their private surroundings.

On the upper floor, the 2 junior suites look out over the roofs to offer a glimpse of Geneva's Jet d'Eau.

The public spaces put guests at ease if they were at home and are adaptable to individual moods and needs. The library books have been carefully chosen to offer tales of travel and unusual discoveries without leaving the comfort of an armchair. The meeting room is available for discreet events in total privacy. Technological equipment is stored out of sight inside the furniture, making the room equally suitable for business and social gatherings. The fitness room, equipped with Technogym exercise machines and a sauna, offers effort, relaxation or both.



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The EASTWEST restaurant, authentic cuisine with a twist



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With a well-earned entry in numerous gourmet guides including *Gault Millau*, the EASTWEST restaurant offers a cuisine of contrasting flavours and colours, in harmony with the spirit of the hotel. Served in the lively atmosphere of the bar or the more intimate setting of the restaurant, the menu offers authentic cuisine with a twist, based on quality, seasonal produce spiced up with a taste of Asia. The gold wallpaper with the Japanese apple trees and the Mario Fortuny suspended silk lampshades all contribute to the warmth of the restaurant which overlooks the patio. From May to October, dining al fresco is possible in the patio.

Outside the restaurant opening hours, the bar remains a select meeting place at any time during the day: the refined décor and pleasant atmosphere make it an ideal setting for a power breakfast, a coffee break or an afternoon tea with cakes and pastries. From 5 p.m., a wide selection of drinks and cocktails appeals to a lively local and cosmopolitan clientele.



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
